

RIDING FOR — A REASON

Just a few friendly reminders and a few rules, rule sheet will be given out at time of registration.

1. Only ATV's and Side by Side's are allowed on this event.
2. No Motorcycles/Dirt Bikes allowed at event.
3. Use of Alcohol is prohibited on the trail 4. Everyone is required to sign a waiver when they check in and before they get on the trail. This will happen when you check in.
5. Helmets are encouraged but not required.
6. Flags are encouraged but not required.
7. No glass or littering on the trails. Please keep the trails cleaned up, we are very fortunate to be given permission to use private property, so please show respect and help keep the trails cleaned up.
8. Idle speed thru the campground.
9. No wheelies, all wheels kept on the ground in the campground.
10. Be courteous, ride safely, lookout for yourself and others. If you see a fellow rider having trouble, please stop and see if they need help or get word back to a R4R crew member so we can get to that participant that needs help out on the trail. You wouldn't want to be left stuck out on the trail broke down, so let's help each other out if you see someone needing help.

There will be a few "Good Samaritan" give-a-ways, more details on this when you arrive.

11. Stay on the trails, and follow the marked signs.
12. No riding in the campground after dark.
13. Main thing is to use common sense.

Please help keep the trails clean and help your fellow riders if they need help along the trails.

There will be security and highway patrol will be visible during the event weekend.
